CONDITIONER STATEMENT

I hereby acknowledge the alfalfa seed described above was received during the (Year) _____ seed conditioning season and the following requirements and restrictions will be observed and followed:

All seed screenings shall be disposed of in such a way that they cannot be distributed or used for food or feed. The seed conditioner shall keep records of screenings disposal for three years from the date of disposal and shall furnish the records to the Director upon request. Disposal records shall consist of documentation from a controlled waste disposal site, incinerator, cogeneration plant, composting facility, or other equivalent disposal site.

No portion of the seed plant, including, but not limited to, green chop, hay, pellets, meal, whole seed, cracked seed, or seed screenings shall be used or distributed for food or feed purposes.

All seed crops grown or conditioned as a nonfood or nonfeed site, in this State, shall bear a tag or container label that forbids the use of the seed for human consumption or animal feed.

No seed grown or conditioned as a nonfood or nonfeed site, in this State, may be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.
